Rules and Regulations

- For their own safety, pets other than dogs are not allowed to participate in the Bark in the Park event.
- Dogs must be wearing an ID tag and kept on a leash at all times.
- Please don't bring your dog if she is in any stage of heat or if your dog is younger than four months of age.
- Please keep your dog under control: unruly participants may be asked to leave.
- Cleanup after your dog. Pooper scooper bags will be provided.
- All participants must sign a waiver.
- Water for dogs will be provided in community bowls.
- The walk is under one mile.
Walkers and their dogs should be in suitable physical condition for this.
